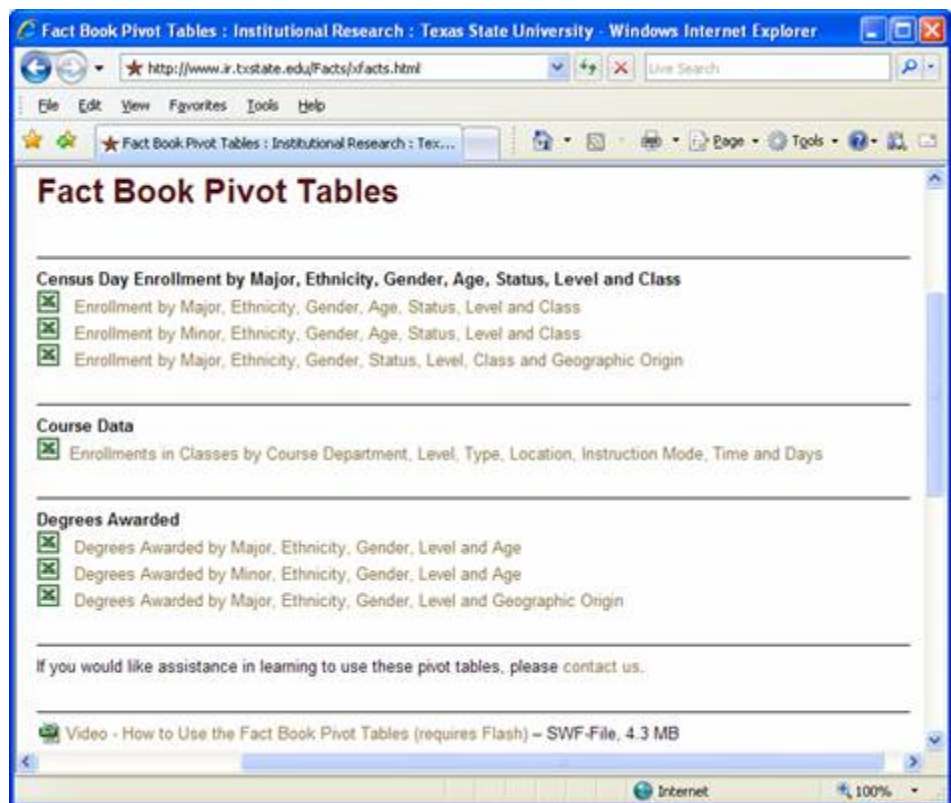

IR has redesigned the On-Line Fact Book using Excel Pivot Tables. These new tables provide more information than the old Fact Book and are much easier to update. Another advantage is that they look and operate much like the data warehouse being developed with AIS to be the future source of official university data.

The new Fact Book provides enrollment data, course data, and degree data. We are in the process of adding faculty and staff data. The use of pivot tables allow us to not only provide tabular data, but also graphical data as well. Additionally, we are now able to publish preliminary 12th day data as well as the certified data. The implementation of the new Fact Book has allowed us to provide more detailed information in a more timely fashion.
